

DECLARATION

COMES NOW, KATHERINE NEPTON, a duly appointed Assistant Attorney General, and aver, upon information and belief, that the foregoing is true. I have reviewed Guam Police Report No. 21-19591 submitted by GPD Officer Ascura and others which sets forth that the following events occurred on Guam.

On or about August 14, 2021, at about 2:41pm, police responded to a violation of court order complaint at a home in Maina. Officer Ascura arrived on scene and met with Sergio Ramiraz (Witness). Witness informs that his daughter, DAISY GUZMAN RAMIREZ II (Defendant), is not permitted to be at his residence and that there is a court order to that effect. Witness informs that Defendant is on pre-trial release in CM0268-21, a Family Violence case. On July 24, 2021 the Honorable Jonathan Quan issued a stay away for Ms. Daisy C. Ramirez against Defendant. And a stay away from Ms. Daisy C. Ramirez's residence against Defendant.

Officer Ascura discovered Defendant to be sitting on the porch of the above-mentioned residence, Ms. Daisy C. Ramirez's home. Officer Ascura asked Defendant if she was aware of the court order and Defendant responded "yes".

Based on the forgoing, there is probable cause to charge DAISY GUZMAN RAMIREZ II with one count of Violation of Court Order (as a Misdemeanor) in violation of Title 9 G.C.A. §30.40(a)(2).

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
