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IN THE SUPERIOR COURT OF GUAM DECLARATION

COMES NOW, Jeremiah B. Luther, a duly appointed Assistant Attorney General, and aver upon information and belief, that the following is true and correct to the best of my knowledge:

I have reviewed Guam Police Report No. 21-19642 submitted by officers of the Guam Police Department ("GPD"), which sets forth the following events occurred on Guam:

On or about August 15, 2021, at approximately 4:05 am, GPD officers responded to report of damage to a vehicle at the Hemlani Apartments in Harmon, Guam. A responding officers spoke with security guard *Sam Kasty* (witness). Kasty reported that prior to calling police, he observed a drunk man damaging cars in the parking lot of the Hemlani apartment. One of the vehicles that the male damaged was a red, Toyota Corolla. The owner of the vehicle was located and identified as *AP Farata* (victim). Farata confirmed that his brother (Tomnor Lorenzo) gifted the Toyota to him [Farata] when Tomnor left to the United States. Farata inspected his vehicle and confirmed that a rear tail light was broken and that the damage was new. An officer also observed the damage. The report contains a damage cost estimate of \$500.00.

Kasty directed officers to the man he observed causing damage to the red Toyota, later identified as **REXTER ROMOT** (dob:11/16/1996) (Defendant). When ROMOT was located, he was hiding between two cars in the parking lot. Kasty specified that he observed ROMOT kicking the rear taillight of the red Toyota before he called police.

ROMOT invoked his right to silence.

ROMOT is believed to be a residence of the Hemlani's apartment where the victim also resides.

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge **REXTER ROMOT** (dob:11/16/1996) (Defendant) with:

*Criminal Mischief (Misdemeanor), in violation of 9 GCA §§ 34.50(c) & 34.60(c); and *Disorderly Conduct (Petty Misdemeanor), in violation of 9 GCA § 61.15 (a)(1), (c).

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct. Executed this 16th day of August, 2021.
