

IN THE SUPERIOR COURT OF GUAM
AMENDED DECLARATION

I, RICHELLE Y. CANTO, a duly appointed Assistant Attorney General, aver upon information and belief that the following declaration is true. I have reviewed Guam Police Department (GPD) Report # 21-22160 submitted by Officer A.C. Ascura (#4116), which revealed the following occurred in Guam:

On or about September 12, 2021, at approximately 1:00 p.m., GPD officers responded to a physical disturbance within a motor vehicle at Route 4, Yona, Guam. Officers arrived at a residence and met with [REDACTED] (victim) who stated "my wife needs help."

[REDACTED] told officers his wife ANASTASIA CATRIONA SABLAN (defendant) had become upset while he was driving their vehicle to pick up his coworker. [REDACTED] reported SABLAN told him that she "just wants to get out of the car." [REDACTED] indicated SABLAN refused to wait until she was dropped home, and instead attempted to exit the vehicle while it was moving. [REDACTED] stated he grabbed SABLAN to prevent her from jumping out of the vehicle, but SABLAN bit his right hand, causing it to bleed. When they arrived at SABLAN's house, she punched [REDACTED] twice on his face near the right side of his mouth. [REDACTED] stated he ran across the street to borrow a phone to call the police.


Officers found SABLAN at her parents' residence locked inside a kennel with a dog. Officers attempted to persuade her to exit, which she did after five (5) minutes. SABLAN refused to acknowledge or waive her rights and no interview was conducted.

Officers noted the following injuries on [REDACTED] a bite mark on the middle knuckle approximately 1 inch in length, which was bleeding profusely. Swelling on the right side of his lips and bruising.

While in her holding cell, SABLAN became "very irate" and hit her head against the cement wall "an unknown amount of times." A medic unit was requested, and officers observed a contusion on SABLAN's forehead approximately 1 inch in diameter.

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge ANASTASIA CATRIONA SABLAN with one (1) count of FAMILY VIOLENCE (as a Misdemeanor), in violation of Title 9 GCA §§30.10(a)(1) and (b) and 30.20(a).

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
