

**IN THE SUPERIOR COURT OF GUAM**  
**DECLARATION**

I, CHRISTINE SANTOS TENORIO, a duly appointed Assistant Attorney General, aver upon information and belief that the following declaration is true. I have reviewed Guam Police Report 21-21932 by P.O. Cruz and others, which revealed the following occurred in Guam:

On or about September 9, 2021, at approximately 9:28 p.m., officers of the Guam Police Department responded to a criminal sexual complaint at an Asan residence. Officers met with J.S. (DOB 10/21/1988), who stated that she was sexually assaulted by JOAQUIN PETER CASTRO NEDEDOG ("Defendant"), a male known to her.

While inside the Asan residence, the Defendant repeatedly asked the Victim to have sex, but the Victim refused. The Defendant became agitated. The Defendant then groped the Victim's chest and buttocks. The Defendant proceeded to rip her blue shirt, bra, and necklace off her body, causing pain to the back of the Victim's neck. The Victim tried to exit the residence, but the Defendant blocked the door with his foot. The Defendant continued to touch the Victim's chest and buttocks.

The Victim was able to calm the Defendant down and depart the residence. As the Victim exited, the Defendant retrieved a stick and told the Victim that he was going to kill everyone that the Victim lived with.

A family member of the Victim verified that the Victim's clothes were not ripped before she entered the Defendant's residence. The family member observed that the Victim was in an emotional state. Police were able to take photographs of the Victim's ripped clothing.

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge JOAQUIN PETER CASTRO NEDEDOG with:

1. ASSAULT WITH INTENT TO COMMIT CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONDUCT (as a Third Degree Felony), in violation of 9 GCA § 25.35 and 9 GCA § 19.30(a)(1);
2. FOURTH DEGREE CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONDUCT (as a Misdemeanor), in violation of 9 GCA § 25.30(a)(1) and (b);
  - a. Touching the buttock of J.S. (DOB 10/21/1988)
3. UNLAWFUL RESTRAINT (as a Misdemeanor), in violation of 9 GCA § 22.35.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
