DECLARATION

I, STEVEN J. HADERLIE, Assistant Attorney General, aver upon information and belief that this declaration is true. I have reviewed Guam Police Report No. 21-21625, submitted by GPD Officer S. Magada and others. It states that the following events occurred on Guam:

On or about September 6, 2021 at about 4:09 p.m., police responded to a report of a disturbance at a Mangilao residence. There, Kaitlyn Miller told police she watched LESTER ANASTACIO assault [REDACTED]. ANASTACIO pushed [REDACTED] back and then ran toward [REDACTED] causing her to sit on the ground. ANASTACIO then hit [REDACTED] with his hand while she was sitting on the ground. Miller had taken video of this incident. Police watched the video and saw that it confirmed Miller's account.

ANASTACIO told police that [REDACTED] is his girlfriend of five years.

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge LESTER ANASTACIO with the following:

- One count of FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a Misdemeanor) against [REDACTED] in violation of 9 GCA §§ 30.10(a)(1) and 30.20(a).
