

IN THE SUPERIOR COURT OF GUAM

DECLARATION

COMES NOW, SEAN BROWN, a duly appointed Assistant Attorney General, and assert, upon information and belief, that the following is true.

I have reviewed Guam Police Report Nos. 21-21668 and 21-21669 submitted by GPD Officer Ben Cruz and others which sets forth that the following events occurred on Guam.

On or about September 7, 2021, police observed a vehicle traveling in Dededo without a front mounted license plate. Police attempted a traffic stop but the vehicle refused to stop. The vehicle collided with another vehicle before the operator and passenger both fled the vehicle on foot. Officer Cruz grabbed a hold of the operator who was attempting to scale a fence near a residence. Police later identified the operator as RODNEY URMAN (Defendant)(alias: Ronny Herman). As Officer Cruz was holding Defendant, Defendant struck Officer Cruz' forearm in an attempt to flee. Police were eventually able to subdue the Defendant. Police were unable to locate the passenger.

Police noted that the rear license plate attached to Defendant's vehicle belonged to a different vehicle and was fraudulent. Police documents that the DMV system reflected that the Defendant's vehicle, a Camry, should have had the license plate OR2830 but the plate on the Camry was a SJ687 and actually belonged to a BMW vehicle.

Based on the forgoing, there is probable cause to charge RODNEY URMAN (alias: Ronny Herman) with one count of ASSAULT ON A PEACE OFFICER (as a Third Degree Felony) in violation of 9 G.C.A. §§ 19.30(a)(1) and (b); with one count of VEHICLE WITHOUT IDENTIFICATION (as a Misdemeanor) in violation of Title 16 G.C.A. § 9101; and with one count of LEAVING THE SCENE WITH PROPERTY DAMAGE (as a Petty Misdemeanor) in violation of Title 16 G.C.A. § 3501(e) and (g).

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
