### **DECLARATION**

I, STEVEN J. HADERLIE, Assistant Attorney General, aver upon information and belief that this declaration is true. I have reviewed Guam Police Report No. 21-23450, submitted by GPD Officer J. Andrew and others. The report states that these events occurred on Guam:

On or about September 26, 2021 at 9:50 p.m. police spoke with this Dededo residence. Said his brother VICTORINO JAMES ALIK had attacked him earlier that day. Police saw that had the following injuries: a two-inch laceration, bruising, and swelling above his forehead; a two-inch laceration, bruising, and swelling above his left temple; bruising and swelling to various other areas of his face and head; and an abrasion on his right knee and right elbow.

Police returned to the residence on or about September 27, 2021 at about 6:05 a.m. to again speak with about subsequent attacks by ALIK.

Incident 1: On or about September 26, 2021 at 9:50 p.m., told police that an hour earlier, ALIK was drunk and body slammed to the pavement. Then ALIK punched Specific head four or five times in the back of the head.

Incident 2: then got in his car and drove down the street to an aunt's house and waited inside his car for about five minutes. ALIK arrived and called names. repeatedly told ALIK he didn't want to fight him. Then helped a cousin there to elevate the cousin's car with a car jack. When finished, he carried the jack back to his cousin. ALIK then stood, approached and punched in the face.

Incident 3: Then select to his mother's house, got some water, and returned to the aunt's house. His cousin asked to borrow value's jumper cables. Then helped his cousin jump start the cousin's car. Then ALIK came from behind varapped a shirt around repeatedly punched him to the ground. ALIK then punched repeatedly punched in the face and head.

Incident 4: Police came and spoke with and his mother, but ALIK wasn't around. then went to his aunt's house and later returned to his mother's house for about 20 minutes. After that, ALIK approached from behind, lifted him into the air, and slammed him to the ground. Then ALIK hit in the head.

Incident 5: went to the hospital and was discharged at about 4:00 a.m. on September 27, 2021. returned to his mother's house and learned that ALIK was there. went and got inside his car. ALIK appeared holding a machete, harassing and threatening and running up to the car. drove away.

One of the times ALIK was punching with on the ground, lost consciousness but regained consciousness when he felt so much pain to his head.

police he saw ALIK striking his head with an unknown object.	The hospital reported that
had facial and scalp contusions and a rib fracture.	1

ALIK and state 's mother, Maryly state, confirmed to police that she saw ALIK sitting on her son state 's stomach with state ying face up on the ground. She watched as ALIK was punching state 's head.

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge VICTORINO JAMES ALIK with the following:

- Two counts of AGGRAVATED ASSAULT (As a 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Felony) against , in violation of 9 GCA § 19.20(a)(2) and (b);
- Two counts of FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Felony) against in violation of 9 GCA § 30.10(a)(1) and 9 GCA § 30.20(a)(1);
- Two counts of FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a Misdemeanor) against violation of 9 GCA § 30.10(a)(1) and 9 GCA § 30.20(a)(1); and
- One count of FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a Misdemeanor) against , in violation of 9 GCA § 30.10(a)(2) and 9 GCA § 30.20(a)(1).
