**MAGISTRATE'S COMPLAINT**

The Attorney General of Guam hereby accuses **LUIS PANGELINAN SABLAN, aka Luis Sablan** of certain crimes committed as follows:

**FIRST CHARGE**

On or about the period between June 1, 2021 to June 14, 2021, *inclusive*, in Guam, **LUIS PANGELINAN SABLAN, aka Luis Sablan** did commit the offense of *Advanced Stalking (As a*

1 **Second Degree Felony**), in that he did willfully, maliciously and repeatedly follow or harass another  
2 person, specifically, **Junie Reyes**, while being prohibited from harassing or contacting **Junie Reyes**  
3 by an order in case number **CF0378-20**, in violation of 9 GCA § 19.70(b) and (e).

5 **SECOND CHARGE**

6 On or about June 14, 2021, in Guam, **LUIS PANGELINAN SABLAN, aka Luis Sablan**  
7 did commit the offense of **Arson (As a Third Degree Felony)**, in that he did unlawfully start a fire  
8 on another's property, to wit: **a Toyota Highlander** in reckless disregard of risk that such would  
9 damage or destroy the property of **Junie Reyes**, in violation of 9 GCA § 34.30(a)(2) and (b).  
10

11 **THIRD CHARGE**

12 On or about June 14, 2021, in Guam, **LUIS PANGELINAN SABLAN, aka Luis Sablan**  
13 did commit the offense of **Criminal Mischief (As a Third Degree Felony)**, in that he did  
14 intentionally damage the motor vehicle of another, to wit: **Junie Reyes**, in violation of 9 GCA  
15 §§ 34.50(d) and 34.60(a).

17 **FOURTH CHARGE**

18 **Count One**

19 On or about June 1, 2021, in Guam, **LUIS PANGELINAN SABLAN, aka Luis Sablan** did  
20 commit the offense of **Violation of Court Order (As a Misdemeanor)**, in that he knowingly violated  
21 a court order pronounced on May 24, 2021, in the Superior Court of Guam Case **CF0378-20** an order  
22 requiring a person to stay away from the residence, dwelling, school, day care center, place of  
23 employment, or any other specified place, within five hundred feet (500) of **Junie Reyes**, in violation  
24 of 9 GCA § 30.40(a)(3) and (b).



**Count Two**

**DECLARATION**

I, RICHELLE Y. CANTO, a duly appointed Assistant Attorney General, aver upon information and belief that the following declaration is true. I have reviewed Guam Police Department (GPD) Reports # 21-13302 and #21-14333 submitted by Officers C.J. Lizama (#625) and T.S. Parinasan (#754), which revealed the following occurred in Guam:

On June 1, 2021, GPD received a complaint from **Junie Reyes** (victim), who informed officers that earlier that morning at approximately 2:00 a.m., her son **Nathaniel Borden** (witness 1) had heard the sound of glass breaking outside of their residence in Asan, Guam. Borden stated he went outside and saw a blue Toyota Yaris passing by their residence, which he knew to be operated by **Reyes' ex-boyfriend LUIS PANGELINAN SABLAN** (defendant). Later that morning, Reyes made a check of her vehicle, a 2011 Silver Toyota Highlander, and noticed a golf ball sized crack on the top front corner of her vehicle.

On June 14, 2021, at approximately 12:10 a.m., GPD responded to a criminal mischief complaint at Reyes' residence. Officers noted the same Toyota Highlander involved in the June 1 incident appeared to have burn marks on it. **Kayana Ulloa** (witness 2), Reyes' daughter, reported she heard her dogs barking and asked her husband **Matthew Ulloa** (witness 3), who was at work, to view their surveillance video, at which time Matthew noticed a spark underneath the vehicle that appeared to grow into a fire. A neighbor came over with a garden hose to put out the fire.

Matthew reports he rushed home to Asan and as he turned onto Reyes' street, he saw the blue Toyota Yaris turning out. Matthew stated he made a u-turn and chased the vehicle for a while until he lost it because it was going faster than 70 miles per hour. Matthew believes **SABLAN** was operating the vehicle as he describes seeing an individual through the front windshield matching **SABLAN's** physical appearance in the driver's seat, and there were no other passengers. Matthew is also in possession of a video recording of a person that appeared to be **SABLAN** causing the explosion to Reyes' Toyota Highlander.

Officers noted the front passenger wheel well and door of the Highlander appeared to have been burnt and melted, exposing the metal body of the vehicle, with pieces of melted plastic on the concrete underneath it. The front passenger door also appeared to have been pried outward and a dent of about 6 inches was seen on the door. Directly below the vehicle was a bottle of tea, with a spout that was melted off, and a strong odor of accelerant believed to be gasoline emitting from the bottle, which was now empty.


**SABLAN** pleaded guilty (*nolo contendere*) to Family Violence and Violation of a Court Order in CF0378-20 on May 24, 2021, and was placed on probation for a period of (2) years during which he is ordered by the Honorable Vernon P. Perez to have no contact with the victim Junie Reyes, and not to harass, assault, or threaten her or any other family or household members. A first violation has been filed by probation on August 4, 2021 for defendant's failure to comply with all of the conditions of his probation.

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge **ROBERT JUNIOR PROJA** with the following:

1. One (1) count of **ADVANCED STALKING** (as a Second Degree Felony), in violation of Title 9 G.C.A. §19.70(b) and (e) - *for the period between June 1 to June 14, 2021*;
2. One (1) count of **ARSON** (as a Third Degree Felony), in violation of Title 9 G.C.A. §34.30(a)(2) and (b). - *on June 14, 2021*;
3. One (1) count of **CRIMINAL MISCHIEF** (as a Third Degree Felony), in violation of Title 9 G.C.A. §§34.50(d) and 34.60(a) - *on June 14, 2021*; and
4. Two (2) counts of **VIOLATION OF A COURT ORDER** (as a Misdemeanor), in violation of Title 9 G.C.A. §30.40(a)(3) and (b) - *count one June 1, 2021, count two June 14, 2021*.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
