DECLARATION

COMES NOW DAVID RIVERA, a duly appointed Assistant Attorney General who avers upon information and belief that the following is true.

I have reviewed Guam Police Report numbers 21-25553 and 21-26221 submitted by Police Officer Matias Lizama. Those reports have revealed the following:

On or about the period of September 13, 2021, to October 17, 2021, inclusive, in Guam, **JIREENA GABRIELE BLAS** ("defendant") filled in and completed the following blank checks belonging to the First Hawaiian Bank checking account of 83 year old Mildred S. Lujan ("victim"): # 424 dated October 3, 2021, # 429 dated October 9, 2021, # 430 dated October 10, 2021, # 477 dated September 9, 2021, and # 478 dated September 21, 2021. Defendant made said checks payable to defendant and signed the victim's name on each check without the permission or authority of the victim to fill in any information that would complete said checks nor to sign the name of the victim to said checks. The checks were cashed by the defendant and the total amount of money stolen from the victim's bank account with these checks was THIRTY THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED THIRTY DOLLARS (\$30,630.00). The defendant was interviewed on October 24, 2021, and at first claimed that the victim was old, had bad memory and sometimes made false accusations. When confronted with the checks the defendant asserted her right to silence but when informed that she was being arrested defendant blurted out that she could resolve the issue and make things right and pleaded with the officer to give her a chance.

On or about October 24, 2021, in Guam, at the Tumon Tamuning Precinct Command, officer Lizama conducted a search incident to arrest and found in the defendant's wallet a small resealable bag containing a crystalline substance of suspected methamphetamine which presumptively tested positive for methamphetamine.

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge JIREENA GABRIELE BLAS with THEFT (As a Second Degree Felony), in violation of 9 GCA §§ 43.20 (a), (f) and 43.30 (a) with a SPECIAL ALLEGATION OF VULNERABLE VICTIM SENTENCING ENHANCEMENT pursuant to 9 GCA § 80.37.3, with 5 counts of FORGERY (As a Third Degree Felony) in violation of 9 GCA §§ 46.10 (a)(2) with a SPECIAL ALLEGATION OF VULNERABLE VICTIM SENTENCING ENHANCEMENT pursuant to 9 GCA § 80.37.3 and with POSSESSION OF A SCHEDULE II CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE in violation of 9 GCA §§67.401.2 (a) and (b).

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct. Executed this 25th
