7 of *Theft (As a 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Felony)*, as alleged in the First Charge above, to a  
8 vulnerable victim, that is, *Mildred S. Lujan*, an elderly person or senior citizen who  
9 is fifty-five years old or older at the time of the crime committed upon her under the  
10 language of 9 GCA § 80.37.3(a) and (c)(1).

17 adding, inserting or changing matter, an incomplete written instrument into a complete one, without  
18 the authority of anyone entitled to grant it, that is: *personal check #424 drawn on Mildred S. Lujan's*  
19 *First Hawaiian checking account*, so that the complete written instrument falsely appears or purports  
20 to be in all respects an authentic creation of its ostensible maker or authorized by her, in violation

25 On or about October 3, 2021, in Guam, **JIREENA GABRIELE BLAS** did  
26 knowingly commit a crime of *Forgery (As a 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Felony)*, as alleged in the  
27 Second Charge, Count One above, to a vulnerable victim, that is, *Mildred S. Lujan*,  
28 an elderly person or senior citizen who is fifty-five years old or older at the time of  
the crime committed upon her under the language of 9 GCA §§ 80.37.3(a) and (c)(1).

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**Count Two**

On or about October 9, 2021, Guam, **JIREENA GABRIELE BLAS**, did knowingly commit the offense of *Forgery (As a 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Felony)*, in that she did, unlawfully and with the intent to defraud and injure *Mildred S. On or about September 9, 2021, in Guam, **JIREENA GABRIELE BLAS** did knowingly commit a crime of *Forgery (As a 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Felony)*, as alleged in the Second Charge, Count Four above, to a vulnerable victim, that is, *Mildred S. Lujan*, an elderly person or senior citizen who is fifty-five years old or older at the time of the crime committed upon her under the language of 9 GCA §§ 80.37.3(a) and (c)(1).

**Count Five**

On or about September 21, 2021, Guam, **JIREENA GABRIELE BLAS** did knowingly commit the offense of *Forgery (As a 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Felony)*, in that she did, unlawfully and with the intent to defraud and injure *Mildred S. Lujan* with knowledge that a fraud and injury to be

1 perpetrated by **JIREENA GABRIELE BLAS**, falsely completes a written instrument by  
2 transforming through adding, inserting or changing matter, an incomplete written instrument into  
3 a complete one, without the authority of anyone entitled to grant it, that is: *personal check #478*  
4 *drawn on Mildred S. Lujan's First Hawaiian checking account*, so that the complete written  
5 instrument falsely appears or purports to be in all respects an authentic creation of its ostensible  
6 maker or authorized by her, in violation of 9 GCA § 46.10(a)(2).

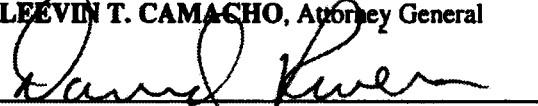
11 On or about October 9, 2021, in Guam, **JIREENA GABRIELE BLAS** did

21 amphetamine-based substance, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 67.401.2(a) and (b).

DECLARATION

COMES NOW DAVID RIVERA, a duly appointed Assistant Attorney General who avers upon information and belief that the following is true.

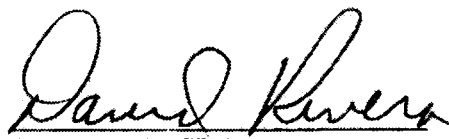
I have reviewed Guam Police Report numbers 21-25553 and 21-26221 submitted by Police Officer Matias Lizama. Those reports have revealed the following:

On or about the period of September 13, 2021, to October 17, 2021, inclusive, in Guam, **JIREENA GABRIELE BLAS** (“defendant”) filled in and completed the following blank checks belonging to the First Hawaiian Bank checking account of 83 year old Mildred S. Lujan (“victim”): # 424 dated October 3, 2021, # 429 dated October 9, 2021, # 430 dated October 10, 2021, # 477 dated September 9, 2021, and # 478 dated September 21, 2021. Defendant made said checks payable to defendant and signed the victim’s name on each check without the permission or authority of the victim to fill in any information that would complete said checks nor to sign the name of the victim to said checks. The checks were cashed by the defendant and the total amount of money stolen from the victim’s bank account with these checks was THIRTY THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED THIRTY DOLLARS (\$30,630.00). The defendant was interviewed on October 24, 2021, and at first claimed that the victim was old, had bad memory and sometimes made false accusations. When confronted with the checks the defendant asserted her right to silence but when informed that she was being arrested defendant blurted out that she could resolve the issue and make things right and pleaded with the officer to give her a chance.

On or about October 24, 2021, in Guam, at the Tumon Tamuning Precinct Command, officer Lizama conducted a search incident to arrest and found in the defendant’s wallet a small resealable bag containing a crystalline substance of suspected methamphetamine which presumptively tested positive for methamphetamine.

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge **JIREENA GABRIELE BLAS** with THEFT (As a Second Degree Felony), in violation of 9 GCA §§ 43.20 (a), (f) and 43.30 (a) with a *SPECIAL ALLEGATION OF VULNERABLE VICTIM SENTENCING ENHANCEMENT* pursuant to 9 GCA § 80.37.3, with 5 counts of FORGERY (As a Third Degree Felony) in violation of 9 GCA §§ 46.10 (a)(2) with a *SPECIAL ALLEGATION OF VULNERABLE VICTIM SENTENCING ENHANCEMENT* pursuant to 9 GCA § 80.37.3 and with POSSESSION OF A SCHEDULE II CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE in violation of 9 GCA §§67.401.2 (a) and (b).
