MAGISTRATE'S COMPLAINT

The Attorney General of Guam hereby accuses **SHAYNE CLEMENSON COURTNEY**
(*aka Shayne Marie Clemenson Courtney*) of a certain crime committed as follows:

On or about the 23rd day of October, 2021, in Guam, **SHAYNE CLEMENSON COURTNEY** (*aka Shayne Marie Clemenson Courtney*) did commit the offense of *Family Violence (As a Misdemeanor)*, in that she did recklessly cause or attempt to cause bodily injury to another family member or household member, *that is:* in violation of 9 GCA §§ 30.10(a)(1) and 30.20(a).

DECLARATION

I, STEVEN J. HADERLIE, Assistant Attorney General, aver upon information and belief that this declaration is true. I have reviewed Guam Police Report No. 21-26131, submitted by GPD Officer J. Varela and others. The report states that these events occurred on Guam:

On or about October 23, 2021 at around 10:11 a.m., police responded to a disturbance in Chalan Pago. Police spoke with [REDACTED] (victim) who said his wife, SHAYNE CLEMENSON COURTNEY (defendant) attacked him. He said that during an argument that morning, she punched and scratched him. She splashed him with water from a glass cup and then threw the cup at him. The glass cup shattered and caused him to have cuts to his ankle area. [REDACTED] said SHAYNE threw another glass at him but missed.

Police observed [REDACTED] to have scratches on his back, arms, and chest. He also had cuts about three inches in length on his ankle area. He also had a bite mark on his right arm.

SHAYNE admitted to throwing the glass cup at [REDACTED]. She also said the scratches on [REDACTED] arms and back are from her but the bite mark is not. [REDACTED] showed police shattered pieces of glass in the garbage and said it was the from the shattered cup.

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge SHAYNE CLEMENSON COURTNEY with:

- One count of FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a Misdemeanor), against [REDACTED], in violation of 9 GCA §§ 30.10(a)(1) and 30.20(a).
