


1 On or about the 30th day of September, 2021, in Guam, **CALVIN CALVIN LIKIAK** (*aka*

IN THE SUPERIOR COURT OF GUAM
DECLARATION

I, CHRISTINE SANTOS TENORIO, a duly appointed Assistant Attorney General, aver upon information and belief that the following declaration is true. I have reviewed a synopsis of Guam Police Report 21-23781 submitted by Officer Gumataotao and others, which revealed the following occurred in Guam:

On or about September 30, 2021, at approximately 1:16 a.m., officers of the Guam Police Department responded to an assault complaint that occurred at an abandoned building in Anigua. A passerby had heard a female screaming for help from within the building. The female had managed to escape and call police from a gas station nearby.

Officers arrived at the gas station and met with [REDACTED] ("Victim"), who explained that she was assaulted by her boyfriend, CALVIN CALVIN LIKIAK ("Defendant"). While the couple was in the abandoned building earlier that morning, the Victim lit a cigarette. A cigarette spark landed on the Defendant's feet, angering him. The Defendant punched the Victim in the face five times. The Victim pleaded with the Defendant to stop, but the Defendant refused. The Victim screamed for help and tried to escape, but the Defendant pulled the Victim back into the building.

Police observed swelling and bruising to the Victim's right cheek and temple area. Medics arrived on scene to treat the Victim.

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge CALVIN CALVIN LIKIAK with:

1. FAMILY VIOLENCE (as a Misdemeanor), in violation of 9 G.C.A. § 30.10(a)(1) and 9 G.C.A. § 30.20(a).

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
