MAGISTRATE'S COMPLAINT

The Attorney General of Guam hereby accuses **TIMOTHY KENIT SUTA aka Teemy Kend** of certain crimes committed as follows:

FIRST CHARGE

Count One

On or about the 27th day of February, 2021, in Guam, **TIMOTHY KENIT SUTA aka Teemy Kend** did commit the offense of **STRANGULATION (As a 3rd Degree Felony)**, in that he did knowingly or intentionally, against the will of another, impede the normal breathing or circulation of the blood of _____, by applying pressure to the throat or neck or by

1 blocking the nose or mouth of [REDACTED] in violation of 9 GCA §§ 19.80(a) and (b).

3 **Count Two**

4 On or about the 5th day of May, 2021, in Guam, **TIMOTHY KENIT SUTA aka Teemy**
5 **Kend** did commit the offense of *STRANGULATION (As a 3rd Degree Felony)*, in that he did
6 knowingly or intentionally, against the will of another, impede the normal breathing or circulation
7 of the blood of [REDACTED], by applying pressure to the throat or neck or by blocking the
8 nose or mouth of [REDACTED] in violation of 9 GCA §§ 19.80(a) and (b).

10 **SECOND CHARGE**

11 **Count One**


12 On or about the 27th day of February, 2021, in Guam, **TIMOTHY KENIT SUTA aka**
13 **Teemy Kend** did commit the offense of *Family Violence*, in that he did recklessly cause or attempt
14 to cause bodily injury to another family member or household member, that is, [REDACTED]
15 [REDACTED], in violation of 9 GCA §§ 30.10(a)(1) and 30.20(a).

17 **Count Two**

18 On or about the 5th day of May, 2021, in Guam, **TIMOTHY KENIT SUTA aka Teemy**
19 **Kend** did commit the offense of *Family Violence*, in that he did recklessly cause or attempt to cause
20 bodily injury to another family member or household member, that is, [REDACTED], in
21 violation of 9 GCA §§ 30.10(a)(1) and 30.20(a).

DECLARATION

COMES NOW DAVID RIVERA, a duly appointed Assistant Attorney General who avers upon information and belief that the following is true.


I have reviewed Guam Police Report number 21-05164 submitted by Police Officer Patrick Corpuz. and Guam Police Report number 21-11017 submitted by Police Officer Christopher Dawson. Those reports have revealed the following:

On or about February 27, 2021, in Guam, Police Officer Corpuz responded to a disturbance at the Songs Apartment, Route 8, Barrigada Guam, where he observed [REDACTED] ("victim") uncontrollably crying. The victim informed the officer that **TIM SUTA**, later identified to be **TIMOTHY KENIT SUTA aka TEEMY KENT** ("defendant"), is her live in boyfriend with whom she has one daughter and is three months pregnant with their second child. The defendant became upset with the victim because defendant did not like her tone of voice and began cursing and yelling at her. The defendant then slapped the victim four or five times across the face, grabbed her by the hair and pulled her head side to side, then used both of his hands to choke her and force her backwards onto their bed where the defendant continued to apply pressure to the victim's neck. She did not lose consciousness. The victim's neck was noted to have a red discoloration.

On or about May 5th, 2021, in Guam, Police Officer Dawson responded to a report of a physical altercation near the Golden Motel in Tamuning, Guam. Officer Dawson met with [REDACTED] ("victim") who informed him that she and her boyfriend Timothy Kenit Suta were coming from a doctor's appointment where she was seen for her pregnancy with the defendant's second child. The defendant had become upset with the victim's doctor and had to be asked to leave. As the victim and the defendant were walking away from the office the defendant was angry and grabbed the victim's purse pulling it and telling the victim to "hurry up." The strap to the purse broke and the victim became scared and did not want to follow the defendant. The defendant grabbed the victim by the shirt to pull her along. The victim resisted and the defendant grabbed her by the neck with one hand and began to choke her telling her to "hurry up." The defendant then punched the victim on her right temple area and pushed her head backwards three times causing her head to twice hit the wall of the building they were next to. The victim stated that she was dizzy. The officer did not observe any physical injuries.

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge **TIMOTHY KENIT SUTA aka TEEMY KENT** with 2 counts of **STRANGULATION** (As a Third Degree Felony) in violation of 9 GCA § 19.80 and with 2 counts of **FAMILY VIOLENCE** (As a Third Degree Felony) in violation of 9 GCA §§30.10(a)(1), 30.10(b)(7) and 30.20(a).

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct. Executed this 4th day of October, 2021.
