MAGISTRATE'S COMPLAINT

The Attorney General of Guam hereby accuses AMSON MWARECHEONG (aka Amson Mwarecheung) of certain crimes committed as follows:

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FIRST CHARGE

On or about the 14th day of October, 2021, in Guam, **AMSON MWARECHEONG** (*aka Amson Mwarecheung*), did commit the offense of *Terrorizing (As a 3rd Degree Felony)*, in that he did knowingly communicate a threat to another person, that is, [REDACTED], to commit or to cause to be committed, a crime of violence dangerous to human life against [REDACTED], and the natural and probable consequence of such threat being to place [REDACTED], in reasonable fear that the crime would be committed, in violation of 9 GCA § 19.60(a), (b).

SECOND CHARGE

Count One

On or about the 24th day of September, 2021, in Guam, **AMSON MWARECHEONG** (*aka Amson Mwarecheung*), did commit the offense of *Aggravated Assault (As a 3rd Degree Felony)*, in that he did recklessly cause or attempt to cause bodily injury to another, that is, [REDACTED], with a deadly weapon, that is, *a machete*, in violation of 9 GCA § 19.20(a)(3) and (b).

Count Two

On or about the 24th day of September, 2021, in Guam, **AMSON MWARECHEONG** (*aka Amson Mwarecheung*), did commit the offense of *Aggravated Assault (As a 3rd Degree Felony)*, in that he did recklessly cause or attempt to cause bodily injury to another, that is, [REDACTED], with a deadly weapon, that is, *a motor vehicle*, in violation of 9 GCA § 19.20(a)(3) and (b).

THIRD CHARGE

Count One

On or about the 24th day of September, 2021, in Guam, **AMSON MWARECHEONG** (*aka Amson Mwarecheung*), did commit the offense of *Criminal Mischief (As a 3rd Degree Felony)*,

1 in that he did intentionally damage the motor vehicle of another, belonging to [REDACTED], in
2 violation of 9 GCA §§ 34.50(d) and 34.60(a), as amended.

5 On or about the 14th day of October, 2021, in Guam, AMSON MWARECHEONG (*aka*
6 **Amson Mwarecheung**), did commit the offense of *Criminal Mischief (As a 3rd Degree Felony)*,
7 in that he did intentionally damage the motor vehicle of another, belonging to [REDACTED], in
8 violation of 9 GCA §§ 34.50(d) and 34.60(a), as amended.

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10 **FOURTH CHARGE**

11 ***Count One***

12 On or about the 24th day of September, 2021, in Guam, AMSON MWARECHEONG (*aka*
13 **Amson Mwarecheung**), did commit the offense of *Family Violence (As a Misdemeanor)*, in that
14 he did recklessly place a family or household member, to wit, [REDACTED], in reasonable fear
15 of imminent bodily injury, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 30.10(a)(2) and 30.20(a).

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17 ***Count Two***

18 On or about the 24th day of September, 2021, in Guam, AMSON MWARECHEONG (*aka*
19 **Amson Mwarecheung**), did commit the offense of *Family Violence (As a Misdemeanor)*, in that
20 he did recklessly place a family or household member, to wit, [REDACTED], in reasonable fear
21 of imminent bodily injury, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 30.10(a)(2) and 30.20(a).

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23 **FIFTH CHARGE**


24 On or about the 14th day of October, 2021, in Guam, AMSON MWARECHEONG (*aka*
25 **Amson Mwarecheung**), did commit the offense of *Family Violence (As a Misdemeanor)*, in that
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he did recklessly cause or attempt to cause bodily injury to another family or household member, that is, [REDACTED], in violation of 9 GCA §§ 30.10(a)(1) and 30.20(a).

PRIORS

DECLARATION

I, GRANT OLAN, a duly appointed Assistant Attorney General, aver upon information and belief that the following declaration is true. I have reviewed Guam Police Reports 21-23305 and 21-25241 by Police Officer J. Asprer and others, which revealed the following occurred in Guam:

On or about September 24, 2021, at approximately 1:36 p.m., Officer Asprer responded to a call about a disturbance in Dededo. Upon his arrival, paramedics: (1) informed him that [REDACTED] (“Victim”) had sustained injuries that included a laceration to her chest; and (2) noted that there were shards of broken glass. Officer Asprer subsequently met with the Victim, who relayed the following. She had been shopping at the Tumon Heights Supermarket and was in her car, a 2014 Nissan Versa, when her boyfriend, **AMSON MWARECHEONG** (AKA Amson Mwarecheung) (“Defendant”), drove his car into her driver side door. The Defendant exited his car and struck the Victim’s driver side window with a machete, which shattered the glass, and fearing for her safety, she quickly drove away. She then drove to her sister-in-law’s house in Dededo, and her sister-in-law, Fuly Mwarecheung, called for paramedics. The Victim thought the Defendant was mad at her because of money. Officer Asprer observed that: (1) there was a twelve-inch dent and scratch on the driver side door of the Victim’s car; and (2) her driver side door was completely shattered, with broken pieces of glass in the car. A request was made for an All Points Bulletin (“APB”) for the Defendant.

On or about October 14, 2021, at approximately 1:36 p.m., Officer M. Ramos responded to a call about a disturbance along Route 28 in Dededo. Upon his arrival, he encountered the Victim, who appeared to be distraught and relayed the following. She gave the Defendant a ride in her car to UR Market so that he could check his mailbox at the store. The Victim got impatient while waiting for the Defendant at UR Market and asked him to “hurry it up” because she needed to meet her realtor, in response to which the Defendant “got mad” and “flicked” his lit cigarette at her. The cigarette landed on the back of the Victim’s neck, after which she yelled at the Defendant, who directed her to “start the car” so that they could go back to his house before “he breaks the car.” While headed southbound on Route 28, the Defendant: (1) struck the passenger side mirror and gear stick of the car with a machete; and (2) then turned toward the Victim, while still holding the machete, and said in Chuukese, “If you stop the car anywhere, I’m gonna chop you.” Due to the Defendant striking the gear stick, the car shifted into the neutral position, forcing the Victim to pullover and stop the car onto the shoulder, after which she exited the vehicle and sat on the side of the road. The Defendant, who followed the Victim out of the car, tried pulling her off the ground, but she pushed him away, and during that encounter, the Defendant punched the Victim in the face. A witness driving by stopped her car to assist the Victim and called the police, after which the Defendant fled the scene in the Victim’s car.

The Victim wrote a statement corroborating the details of the events that took place on or about October 14, 2021. She also relayed to Officer Ramos that: (1) she had been in

a romantic relationship with the Defendant since 2014, but that it had been "on and off" due to fights; (2) they have three children together; and (3) they live together. Officer Ramos asked the Victim how she felt at the time of the incident, to which she responded, "scared," and she requested placement at a protective shelter because she did not have any other place that she could go for lodging. Officer Ramos also observed that the Victim had: (1) a bruised left hand; (2) a bump behind her left ear; (3) a bloody nose and mouth; and (4) pants that were soiled, possibly from urine.

Officer Ramos requested an APB for the Defendant and the Nissan Versa. The Defendant was subsequently: (1) reported at Winster Game Room in Harmon, where Officer Ramos observed him in the Nissan Versa; (2) transported to Dededo Precinct Command and interviewed; and (3) placed under arrest.

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge **AMSON MWARECHEONG** with:

1. **TERRORIZING** (as a Third-Degree Felony) against [REDACTED], in violation of 9 GCA § 19.60(a), for the events that took place on or about October 14, 2021;
2. Two counts of **AGGRAVATED ASSAULT** (as a Third-Degree Felony) against [REDACTED], in violation of 9 GCA § 19.20(a)(3) and (b), while driving his car into the driver side door of [REDACTED]'s car, and while shattering the driver side window of [REDACTED] car with a machete, on or about September 24, 2021;
3. Two counts of **CRIMINAL MISCHIEF** (as a Third-Degree Felony), in violation of 9 GCA § 34.50(d) and § 34.60(a), for the events that took place on or about September 24, 2021, and October 14, 2021;
4. Two counts of **FAMILY VIOLENCE** (as a Misdemeanor) against [REDACTED] in violation of 9 GCA § 30.10(a)(2) and § 30.20(a), while driving his car into the driver side door of [REDACTED] car, and while shattering the driver side window of [REDACTED] car with a machete, on or about September 24, 2021; and
5. **FAMILY VIOLENCE** (as a Misdemeanor) against [REDACTED], in violation of 9 GCA § 30.10(a)(1) and § 30.20(a), for the events that took place on or about October 14, 2021.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
