MAGISTRATE'S COMPLAINT

The Attorney General of Guam hereby accuses **S. VICK SERIOUS** of certain crime committed as follows:

FIRST CHARGE

On or about the 17th day of October, 2021, in Guam, **S. VICK SERIOUS**, did commit the offense of *Aggravated Assault (As a 3rd Degree Felony)*, in that he did recklessly cause or attempt to cause bodily injury to another, that is, with a deadly weapon, that is, *a glass bottle*, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 19.20(a)(3) and (b).

1 **SPECIAL ALLEGATION**

2 *Possession or Use of a Deadly Weapon in the*
3 *Commission of a Felony*

4 On or about the 17th day of October, 2021, in Guam, **S. VICK SERIOUS**,
5 did knowingly and unlawfully possess or use a deadly weapon, that is, *a glass bottle*,
6 in the commission of a felony, that is, **Aggravated Assault (As a 3rd Degree**
Felony), as charged in the First Charge above, in violation of 9 GCA § 80.37.

8 **SECOND CHARGE**

9 **Count One**

10 On or about the 17th day of October, 2021, in Guam, **S. VICK SERIOUS**, did commit the
11 offense of *Criminal Mischief (As a 3rd Degree Felony)*, in that he did intentionally damage the
12 motor vehicle of another, to wit: *a Toyota Echo belonging to [REDACTED]*, in violation of 9 GCA
13 §§ 34.50(d) and 34.60(a), as amended.

14 **Count Two**

15 On or about the 17th day of October, 2021, in Guam, **S. VICK SERIOUS**, did commit the
16 offense of *Criminal Mischief (As a 3rd Degree Felony)*, in that he did intentionally damage the
17 motor vehicle of another, to wit: *a Toyota Corolla belonging to [REDACTED]*, in violation of 9 GCA
18 §§ 34.50(d) and 34.60(a), as amended.

19 **THIRD CHARGE**

20 On or about the 17th day of October, 2021, in Guam, **S. VICK SERIOUS**, did commit the
21 offense of *Attempted Third Degree Robbery (As a 3rd Degree Felony)*, in that he did attempt to
22 unlawfully use force against [REDACTED], with the intent to overcome the physical resistance or
23 physical power of resistance of [REDACTED], while in the course of committing theft of *a fanny pack*
24 *and cellphone*, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 40.30(a)(1) and (b), and 13.10.



DECLARATION

I, STEVEN J. HADERLIE, Assistant Attorney General, aver upon information and belief that this declaration is true. I have reviewed Guam Police Report No. 21-25520, submitted by GPD Officer S. Artui and others. The report states that these events occurred on Guam:

On or about October 17, 2021 at about 4:48 a.m. police spoke with [REDACTED] (victim 1) who said her boyfriend of six months, S. VICK SERIOUS (defendant), had just attacked her outside their apartment in Tamuning. She said SERIOUS was drinking beer and then began drinking Jack Daniel's whiskey. In the parking lot, SERIOUS pushed her in the back. Then he grabbed her by the hair and held her on the ground. SERIOUS put [REDACTED] in a chokehold and choked her for a couple of seconds. She started screaming. Police later saw that [REDACTED] had a laceration to her finger and a bump on her head.

SERIOUS also damaged [REDACTED] car, a Toyota Echo. He shattered the driver side window using a ratchet-style nylon tie strap. Police noted the window was broken and saw pieces of glass inside the vehicle.

Security guard [REDACTED] (victim 2) heard the commotion and ran toward [REDACTED] to help. SERIOUS struck [REDACTED] with a glass bottle, grabbed [REDACTED] shirt collar, and demanded that [REDACTED] give him his fanny pack and cell phones. SERIOUS attempted to pull the fanny pack which was strapped around [REDACTED] body. SERIOUS punched [REDACTED] in the face and body several times. The two rolled in the grassy area and then [REDACTED] broke free. SERIOUS also smashed in the rear window of [REDACTED] vehicle, a Toyota Corolla, using the ratchet strap.

[REDACTED] showed police where the confrontation occurred and showed police an empty glass Jack Daniel's whiskey bottle laying there in the grass. Police saw that [REDACTED] car rear window was broken with a foot-long oblong hole. Glass fragments were strewn around the interior.

Police saw that [REDACTED] had several abrasions to his face and neck and complained of pain to his abdomen, head, and face. [REDACTED] clothing was disheveled, and his collar appeared to be scrunched together. There was slight swelling and a small laceration to the rear of [REDACTED] head.

Police spoke with SERIOUS at the scene and noted that SERIOUS was holding a white ratchet strap with a metal buckle. SERIOUS had a strong odor of an intoxicating beverage emitting from his person and breath, bloodshot watery eyes, and slurred speech. SERIOUS admitted to fighting with [REDACTED]. SERIOUS also said he took the ratchet strap from [REDACTED] vehicle. He said he "lost it" and admitted to damaging both cars with the strap. He said he was upset because [REDACTED] kept ignoring him.

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge S. VICK SERIOUS with the following:

- One count of AGGRAVATED ASSAULT (As a 3rd Degree Felony), against [REDACTED], in violation of 9 GCA § 19.20(a)(3) and (b).
 - With a Special Allegation of Possession or Use of a Deadly Weapon, in violation of 9 GCA § 80.37.
- Two counts of CRIMINAL MISCHIEF (As a 3rd Degree Felony) in violation of 9 GCA §§ 34.50(d) and 34.60(a).

ORIGINAL

- One count of ATTEMPTED THIRD DEGREE ROBBERY (As a 3rd Degree Felony) in violation of 9 GCA §§ 40.30(a)(1) and (b) and 13.10.
- One count of FAMILY VIOLENCE (As a Misdemeanor) against [REDACTED], in violation of 9 GCA § 30.10(a)(1) and 9 GCA § 30.20(a)(1).
