MAGISTRATE'S COMPLAINT

The Attorney General of Guam hereby accuses **KERO MAKO** of a certain crime committed as follows:

On or about the 20th day of October, 2021, in Guam, **KERO MAKO** did commit the offense of *Aggravated Assault (As a 3rd Degree Felony)*, in that he did recklessly cause or attempt to cause bodily injury to another, that is, _____, with a deadly weapon, that is, *a pipe*, in violation of 9 GCA § 19.20(a)(3) and (b).

*Possession or Use of a Deadly Weapon

*On or about the 20th day of October, 2021, in Guam, **KERO MAKO** did knowingly and unlawfully possess or use a deadly weapon, that is, a pipe, in the commission of a felony, that is, **Aggravated Assault (As a Third Degree Felony)**, in violation of 9 GCA § 80.37.*

DECLARATION

COMES NOW, Rolland B. Wimberley a duly appointed Assistant Attorney General, aver upon information and belief that the following declaration is true. I have reviewed Guam Police Report 21-25795 submitted by Guam Police Department ("GPD") Officers that indicated the following occurred in Guam:

On or about October 20, 2021, GPD Officers responded to a disturbance complaint Adrian Sanchez Road in Harmon. Officers met with Gus Quichocho (reporting person), who stated that he had seen a physical altercation between a male wearing a green shirt and a female in a Micronesian skirt. Mr. Quichocho observed the male in the green shirt, later identified as **Kero Mako (Defendant)**, to be striking the victim with a pipe or stick. The victim, later identified as Aite Ham (victim), then ran upstairs. The Defendant then dropped the pipe on the ground and followed the victim. The Defendant then strangled the victim and punched her on the left side 3 to 4 times with his right fist. He concluded his statement by pointing out the location where the Defendant had dropped the pipe or stick, and police located and confiscated a metal tube pipe.


The Victim appeared reluctant to speak to officer. She did indicate that she had been crying and Officers noted redness to her face and neck. The victim refused to be photographed. She stated that she had grabbed her husband's telephone and had been yelling at the Defendant but that nothing had happened.

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge **Kero Mako (Defendant)** with:

- 1) **AGGRAVATED ASSAULT (As a Third Degree Felony)**, in violation of 9 GCA § 19.20 (a)(3) and (b);
 - a. **NOTICE of Special Allegation of Possession or Use of a Deadly Weapon in the Commission of a Felony in violation of 9 GCA §80.37**

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
