MAGISTRATE'S COMPLAINT

ORIGINAL

1 The Attorney General of Guam hereby accuses **NATCHUO ILAI** of certain crimes
2 committed as follows:

3 **FIRST CHARGE**

4 ***Count One***

6 On or about the 25th day of October, 2021, in Guam, **NATCHUO ILAI**, did commit the
7 offense of ***Family Violence (As a 3rd Degree Felony)***, in that he did recklessly cause or attempt to
8 cause bodily injury to another family or household member, *i.e.*, [REDACTED], in violation of 9 GCA
9 §§ 30.10(a)(1) and 30.20(a)(3).

10 ***Count Two***

12 On or about the 25th day of October, 2021, in Guam, **NATCHUO ILAI**, did commit the
13 offense of ***Family Violence (As a 3rd Degree Felony)***, in that he did recklessly cause or attempt to
14 cause bodily injury to another family or household member, *i.e.*, [REDACTED], in violation of 9 GCA
15 §§ 30.10(a)(1) and 30.20(a)(3).

16 ***NOTICE:***

17 ***Felony Committed While On Felony Release***

18 The Defendant, **NATCHUO ILAI**, committed the above felony offenses while he
19 was on release pursuant to Chapter 40, Title 8, Guam Code Annotated, on pending
20 felony charges, *i.e.*, ***Possession With Intent To Deliver A Schedule II Controlled***
21 ***Substance By Complicity (As a 1st Degree Felony)***, in violation of 9 GCA
22 § 67.401.1(a)(1), (b) and § 4.60, filed under Superior Court of Guam Criminal Case
23 No. CF0667-19, within the meaning of 9 GCA § 80.37.1(a).

9 On or about the 25th day of October, 2021, in Guam, NATCHUO ILAI, did commit the
10 offense of *Family Violence (As a Misdemeanor)*, in that he did recklessly cause or attempt to cause
11 bodily injury to another family or household member, *i.e.*, [REDACTED], in violation of 9 GCA
12 §§ 30.10(a)(1) and 30.20(a).

14 *Count Two*

15 On or about the 25th day of October, 2021, in Guam, NATCHUO ILAI, did commit the
16 offense of *Family Violence (As a Misdemeanor)*, in that he did recklessly cause or attempt to cause
17 bodily injury to another family or household member, *i.e.*, [REDACTED], in violation of 9 GCA
18 §§ 30.10(a)(1) and 30.20(a).

20 **FOURTH CHARGE**

21 On or about the 23rd day of October, 2021, in Guam, NATCHUO ILAI, did commit the
22 offense of *Violation Of A Court Order (As a Misdemeanor)*, in that he knowingly violated a court
23 order filed on July 4, 2021, in Superior Court of Guam Case No. CM0152-21, enjoining the
24 Defendant from threatening to commit or committing acts of family violence against, or from
25 harassing, annoying, molesting, telephoning, contacting, or otherwise communicating with a family

7 order filed on July 4, 2021, in Superior Court of Guam Case No. CM0152-21, enjoining the
8 Defendant from threatening to commit or committing acts of family violence against, or from
9 harassing, annoying, molesting, telephoning, contacting, or otherwise communicating with a family
10 or household member, *i.e.*, [REDACTED] either directly or indirectly, in violation of 9 GCA
11 § 30.40(a)(1) and (5).

13 **SIXTH CHARGE**

14 On or about the 25th day of October, 2021, in Guam, NATCHUO ILAI, did commit the
15 offense of *Violation Of A Court Order (As a Misdemeanor)*, in that he knowingly violated a court
16 order filed on July 4, 2021, in Superior Court of Guam Case No. CM0152-21, enjoining the
17 Defendant from threatening to commit or committing acts of family violence against, or from
18 harassing, annoying, or molesting, a family or household member, *i.e.*, [REDACTED] in violation of 9
19 GCA § 30.40(a)(1).

IN THE SUPERIOR COURT OF GUAM
DECLARATION

I, GRANT OLAN, a duly appointed Assistant Attorney General, aver upon information and belief that the following declaration is true. I have reviewed Guam Police Report 21-26280, submitted by Police Officer W. Skilling and others, which revealed the following occurred in Guam:

On or about October 25, 2021, at approximately 6:20 a.m., Officer Skilling responded to a disturbance at a Yigo residence. [REDACTED] informed Officer Skilling that: (1) she had an argument that morning with her boyfriend, NATCHUO ILAI ("Defendant"); (2) the Defendant tried grabbing her; and (3) her 21-year-old son, [REDACTED], who had stepped between them, was hit in the stomach and neck by the Defendant. Then, [REDACTED] asserted: (1) she grabbed the Defendant by the rear to protect her son, during which the Defendant reached around and punched her in the back and shoulder multiple times; and (2) her son then pushed the Defendant out the front door, locked him outside of their residence, and called 911. [REDACTED] corroborated [REDACTED] statements, and noted that the Defendant called her a "bitch" and a "whore."

[REDACTED] also asserted that the Defendant bit her two days earlier, on October 23, 2021, during a separate argument, which she had not previously reported because the Defendant insisted that he would change and begged her not to report it. Officer Skilling observed: (1) a bite mark on [REDACTED] right forearm that was approximately two-to-three inches wide, and two-inches long; and (2) that [REDACTED] complained of pain. Following his arrest, the Defendant admitted to: (1) getting into multiple arguments with, and biting, [REDACTED], who he described as a "bitch"; and (2) getting upset at his stepson, [REDACTED] for yelling at him because [REDACTED] was being disrespectful toward him.

The Defendant is currently on pretrial release in CF0667-19 for Possession with Intent to Deliver a Schedule II Controlled Substance by Complicity (as a First-Degree Felony). He has been charged in another pending case, CM0152-21, with Family Violence (as a Misdemeanor) against [REDACTED]. In the latter case, the terms of his order of conditional release and appearance bond states that: (1) "Defendant is ordered to stay away from, and have no contact with the victim(s), . . . including [REDACTED]; and (2) "Defendant is restrained from threatening to commit or committing acts of violence against, or from harassing, annoying, or molesting the victim(s), or other family household members."


Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge NATCHUO ILAI with:

1. Two Counts of FAMILY VIOLENCE (as a Third-Degree Felony) against [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] for the events on October 25, 2021, in violation of 9 G.C.A. §§ 30.10(a)(1) and 30.20(a)(3), with NOTICE: FELONY ON FELONY RELEASE, in violation of 9 G.C.A. § 80.37.1;
2. One Count of FAMILY VIOLENCE (as a Misdemeanor) against [REDACTED] for the events on October 23, 2021, in violation of 9 G.C.A. §§ 30.10(a)(1) and 30.20(a);

3. Two Counts of FAMILY VIOLENCE (as a Misdemeanor) against [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] for the events on October 25, 2021, in violation of 9 G.C.A. §§ 30.10(a)(1) and 30.20(a);
4. One Count of VIOLATION OF A COURT ORDER (as a Misdemeanor) against [REDACTED] for the events on October 23, 2021, in violation of 9 G.C.A. § 30.40(a)(1) and (5);
5. One Count of VIOLATION OF A COURT ORDER (as a Misdemeanor) against [REDACTED] for the events on October 25, 2021, in violation of 9 G.C.A. § 30.40(a)(1) and (5); and
6. One Count of VIOLATION OF A COURT ORDER (as a Misdemeanor) against [REDACTED] for the events on October 25, 2021, in violation of 9 G.C.A. § 30.40(a)(1).

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
