MAGISTRATE'S COMPLAINT

The Attorney General of Guam hereby accuses GINO TEDTAOTAO MUARELUK (aka

Gino Muareluk, aka Gino Tedtaotao, aka "G") of certain crimes committed as follows:

FIRST CHARGE

On or about the 2nd day of October, 2021, in Guam, GINO TEDTAOTAO MUARELUK (aka Gino Muareluk, aka Gino Tedtaotao, aka "G") did commit the offense of Family Violence (As a Misdemeanor), in that he did recklessly place a family member or household member, to wit: in reasonable fear of imminent bodily injury, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 30.10(a)(2) and 30.20(a).

SECOND CHARGE

On or about the 2nd day of October, 2021, in Guam, GINO TEDTAOTAO MUARELUK (aka Gino Muareluk, aka Gino Tedtaotao, aka "G") did commit the offense of Violation of a Court Order (As a Misdemeanor), in that he knowingly violated a court order filed on April 12, 2021, in the Superior Court of Guam Criminal Case No. CM0021-21, enjoining the Defendant from threatening to commit or committing acts of family violence against, or from harassing, annoying, or molesting , a family or household member, or any person named in the order, in violation of 9 GCA § 30.40(a)(1).

DECLARATION

I, RENAIDA Z. SAN NICOLAS, a duly appointed Assistant Attorney General, aver upon information and belief that the following declaration is true. I have reviewed Guam Police Report 21-24053 submitted by Guam Police Officers which revealed the following occurred in Guam:

On or about October 2, 2021, at approximately 3:15 p.m., Guam Police officers responded to a disturbance complaint at a residence in Dededo. reported that her exboyfriend GINO TEDTAOTAO MUARELUK ("Defendant") had broken into her residence. The Victim stated that she and the Defendant were together for approximately twelve years and had recently "separated 2 weeks ago".

At approximately 3:00 p.m. that same day, the Victim was in the bedroom laying on a mattress with one of her children. The Victim then heard banging on the door and was let in by one of their other minor children. She then heard the Defendant yell out "I will hurt you before I go!" The Victim then grabbed one of her children and ran into the bathroom. The Defendant continued to yell and went to the bathroom and attempted to unlock the bathroom door. The Victim had to hold the door and the door knob to prevent the Defendant from entering the bathroom. When the Victim heard sirens, the Defendant appeared to be leaving the residence. The Defendant then left the residence. Throughout the incident the Victim felt scared and believed that the Defendant would have harmed her. The Victim stated that the Defendant was told many times that he was not allowed at her residence.

The Defendant was later located.

The Defendant is currently on probation in CM0021-21 and CM0041-21.

On May 4, 2021, Defendant entered a plea of guilty to Family Violence (as a Misdemeanor) and Violation of Court Order (as a misdemeanor) before the Honorable Judge Maria T. Cenzon in CM0041-21. The victim in CM0041-21 is the same victim in this case. Per that plea agreement, the Defendant was not to harass, assault or threaten the victim.

On June 12, 2021, Defendant entered a plea of guilty to Criminal Mischief (as a misdemeanor) before the Honorable Judge Vernon P. Perez in CM0021-21. The victim in CM0021-21 is the same victim in this case. Per that plea agreement, the Defendant was not to harass, assault or threaten the victim.

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge GINO TEDTAOTAO MUARELUK with:

- 1. FAMILY VIOLENCE (as a Misdemeanor), in violation of 9 GCA. § 30.10(a)(2) and 9 G.C.A. § 30.20(a);
- 2. Two counts of VIOLATION OF A COURT ORDER (as a Misdemeanor), in violation of 9 GCA § 30.40(a)(1); and
- 3. CRIMINAL TRESPASS (As a Petty Misdemeanor) in violation of 9 GCA § 37.30(a).

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
