**MAGISTRATE'S COMPLAINT**

**FIRST CHARGE**

On or about the 6<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2021, in Guam, **JAVIER JAMES LIZAMA**, did commit the offense of *Assault (As a Misdemeanor)*, in that he did recklessly cause or attempt to cause bodily injury to another, that is, *Ryan Muller* in violation of 9 GCA §§ 19.30(a)(1) and (e).

**SECOND CHARGE**

On or about the 6<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2021, in Guam, **JAVIER JAMES LIZAMA**, did commit the offense of *Criminal Trespass (As a Misdemeanor)*, when, knowing that he was not licensed or privileged to do so, he did enter or surreptitiously remain in the habitable property of *Ryan Muller and Marilyn Enote* , in violation of 9 GCA § 37.30(a), as amended.

**DECLARATION**

COMES NOW, LEONARDO M. RAPADAS, a duly appointed Assistant Attorney General, aver upon information and belief that the following declaration is true. I have reviewed Guam Police Report 21-24370 submitted by Guam Police Department ("GPD") Officer V. Perez and others that indicated the following occurred in Guam:

On or about October 6, 2021, at or about 1:49 a.m., the officers responded to a criminal complaint at a Nimitz Towers residence in Piti. At that time, Officer Perez spoke to Ryan Muller ("Victim 1") and Marilyn Enoté ("Victim 2"). Victim 1 told the officer that earlier, at about 1:30 a.m., same date, Victim 2, his girlfriend, told him someone was in the residence and had opened the bedroom door. Victim 1 opened the bedroom door and entered the living room and saw a male, later identified as **JAVIER JAMES LIZAMA ("DEFENDANT")**, exiting out the front door. Victim 1 followed him and heard the door to the nearby trash chute close. Victim 1 opened the door and saw the **DEFENDANT** in there. The **DEFENDANT** then lunged at Victim 1 where they struggled. They eventually went to the ground. The security guard assisted Victim 1 to subdue the **DEFENDANT**.

Victim 2 corroborated Victim 1's account. The **DEFENDANT** had no authority to be in the apartment.


The **DEFENDANT** had been charged in Criminal Court Case No. CM0473-20 with Family Violence (As a Misdemeanor) where he had subsequently entered into a deferred plea agreement.

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge **JAVIER JAMES LIZAMA** with:

1. **ASSAULT (As a Misdemeanor)**, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 19.30(a)(1) and (e);  
and
2. **CRIMINAL TRESPASS (As a Misdemeanor)**, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.30(a).

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
