MAGISTRATE'S COMPLAINT

The Attorney General of Guam hereby accuses **JEFFERSON RAYPHAND** of certain crimes committed as follows:

FIRST CHARGE

On or about the 12th day of October, 2021, in Guam, **JEFFERSON RAYPHAND**, did commit the offense of *Family Violence (As a Misdemeanor)*, in that he did recklessly cause or

1 attempt to cause bodily injury to another family or household member, that is, *Damiana Edin*
2 *Rayphand*, in violation of 9 GCA § 30.10(a)(1) and § 30.20(a).

4 **SECOND CHARGE**

5 On or about the 12th day of October, 2021, in Guam, **JEFFERSON RAYPHAND**, did
6 commit the offense of *Violation Of A Court Order (As a Misdemeanor)*, in that he knowingly
7 violated a court order filed in Superior Court of Guam Case No. CF0189-21, enjoining the Defendant
8 from threatening to commit or committing acts of family violence against, or from harassing,
9 annoying, or molesting, a family or household member, to wit: *Damiana Edin Rayphand*, in
10 violation of 9 GCA § 30.40(a)(1).

DECLARATION

COMES NOW, Alysa Draper-Dehart, a duly appointed Assistant Attorney General, and aver, upon information and belief, that the following is true. I have reviewed the Guam Police Case No. 21-24978 submitted by Officer Gabutin and others, which revealed the following occurred in Guam:

On or about October 12, 2021 at around 2:08 am, officers with the Guam Police Department responded to a assault complaint at the Moti Apartments in Toto. Upon arrival they observed a female, later identified as Damiana Edin Rayphand ("Victim"), walking to the front of the location. Officers approached her and when asked if she contacted police she stated "yes, my husband kicked my face." The Victim reported that she had been laying down on a mattress located on the floor when her husband, **JEFFERSON RAYPHAND ("Defendant")**, started an argument. The Victim started defending herself, the Defendant got upset and kicked her in the face. The Victim shouted which caused her children to wake up, the Victim then left the residence. In a written statement to the police the Victim stated she had shouted in pain and told him to stop. That she was in fear for her life.

Officers quickly found the Defendant and he was then arrested. The Defendant had entered into a deferred plea agreement to Family Violence as a misdemeanor, in CF0189-21 where he plead guilty and was sentenced per the plea on 08/03/2021 by the Honorable Judge Cenzone. The Defendant was ordered to not harass, assault or threaten the victims. One of the victims listed in the indictment was Damiana E. Rayphand.

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge **JEFFERSON RAYPHAND** with:

1. **FAMILY VIOLENCE** (as a Misdemeanor), in violation of 9 GCA § 30.10 (a)(1) and § 30.20 (a)
2. **VIOLATION OF A COURT ORDER** (as a Misdemeanor), in violation of 9 GCA § 30.40 (a)(1)

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
