**IN THE SUPERIOR COURT OF GUAM**  
**DECLARATION**

COMES NOW, Alysa Draper-Dehart, a duly appointed Assistant Attorney General, and aver, upon information and belief, that the following is true. I have reviewed the Guam Police Case No. 21-26579 submitted by Officer Sanchez and others, which revealed the following occurred in Guam:

On or about October 28, 2021 at around 7:30 AM, officers with the Guam Police Department responded to an assault in a black Mitsubishi Mirage at the Circle K in Dededo. Upon arrival officers observed the vehicle and approached noting a female and a male minor in the passenger seat, with a male in the drivers seat. Officers spoke to the female separately and identified her as [REDACTED] ("Victim") who stated her boyfriend, **JACK STEVEN GUARDIANO SANCHEZ** ("Defendant"), was upset with her because the car wouldn't start. The Defendant blamed her for being late and began to yell at her. The Defendant then started to punch her left leg and pushed her against the passenger door. The Victim stated she was afraid because their son, K.J.M. (DOB 12/04/2019) was laying on the passenger seat while the Defendant punched and shoved the Victim. The Victim stated that KJM wasn't hurt but was crying during the incident.

Another officer spoke with the Defendant who stated, after his Miranda Rights were given, that they had woken up and he had gotten upset about the time. That he punched her thigh and pushed her in the vehicle.

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge **JACK STEVEN GUARDIANO SANCHEZ** with:

1. **FAMILY VIOLENCE** (as a Misdemeanor), in violation of 9 GCA § 30.10 (a)(1) and § 30.20 (a)

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
