IN THE SUPERIOR COURT OF GUAM DECLARATION

COMES NOW, LEONARDO M. RAPADAS, a duly appointed Assistant Attorney General, aver upon information and belief that the following declaration is true. I have reviewed Guam Police Report 21-26817 submitted by Guam Police Department ("GPD") Officer A. Penafiel and others that indicated the following occurred in Guam:

On or about October 30, 2021, at or about 11:36 a.m., officers responded to a walk-in assault complaint at the Dededo Precinct Command. At that time, a male individual identified as, Sonny S. Manalang ("Victim") reported that he had been assaulted by a co-worker, identified as ARNEL ZAMORA PATENTES ("DEFENDANT").

The Victim stated that on October 29, 2021, the DEFENDANT had confronted him regarding a chair about which he knew nothing. The two were roommates in their work barracks. The DEFENDANT had taken a "Leatherman" multitool out of its pouch, gripped it, then swung it, and struck the Victim on the forehead causing a small laceration and bleeding. The officers noticed a band-aid on the Victim's forehead area. The DEFENDANT then unfolded the knife in the multitool and threatened the Victim with death if he used it. A coworker had to take the knife away from him.

The officers located the **DEFENDANT** and later interviewed him. He admitted there was an argument regarding chairs, that he became angry, and he started punching the Victim. He admitted using his multitool when he struck the Victim. He also admitted opening the blade and threatening him with it. He told the officers he made a gesture indicating he would slash the Victim's throat.

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge ARNEL ZAMORA PATENTES with:

1. TERRORIZING (As a 3rd Degree Felony), in violation of 9 GCA §§ 19.60(a) and (b) with a SPECIAL ALLEGATION of POSSESSION AND USE OF A DEADLY WEAPON OF THE COMMISSION OF A FELONY, that is, Terrorizing (As a 3rd Degree Felony), in violation of 9 GCA §80.37; and

2. ASSAULT (As a Misdemeanor), in violation of 9 GCA §§ 19.30(a)(1) and (1/2).

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
