## IN THE SUPERIOR COURT OF GUAM DECLARATION

I, CHRISTINE SANTOS TENORIO, a duly appointed Assistant Attorney General, aver upon information and belief that the following declaration is true. I have reviewed Guam Police Report 21-26825 submitted by Officer Mendiola and others, which revealed the following occurred in Guam:

2021 04

On or about October 30, 2019, at approximately 12:13 p.m., officers of the Guam Police Department responded to a disturbance at a Yigo residence. Officer met with ("Victim"), who explained that she had assaulted by her boyfriend, JUSTINO LADORE ("Defendant") earlier that day.

The Victim arrived home from work when she observed the Defendant drinking beer with his friends outside their residence. The Victim stated to the Defendant, "What, you guys don't work but can drink beer?" In response, the Defendant picked up a PVC pipe and struck the Victim's back leg with the pipe. The Victim was in fear and ran to her neighbor's house to contact police.

Officers observed a purple and red bruise behind the Victim's left thigh that was approximately four inches long and one inch wide. Police observed that the Defendant seemed intoxicated. The Defendant admitted that he hit the Victim with the pipe.

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge **JUSTINO LADORE** with:

1. FAMILY VIOLENCE (as a Misdemeanor), in violation of 9 G.C.A. § 30.10(a)(1) and 9 G.C.A. § 30.20(a); and
