On March 25, 2022, around 2:35AM, Patrol Officers assigned to Tumon Tamuning Precinct attempted to conduct a traffic stop on a primer black sedan on Ypao Rd. in Tumon. The vehicle license plates attached to the sedan were identified as Fraudulent. The operator of the vehicle refused to come to a stop and attempted to evade the officers and a pursuit ensued.

The pursuit led the officers towards Pagat Mangilao and ended with the operator of the vehicle intentionally ramming into several patrol vehicles. An officer was identified to have sustained injuries because of the collision and was provided medical attention.

The investigation led to the arrest of four (4) male adults.

The operator, Andrew V. Toves, 38YOA, was arrested for the offense of Eluding a Police Officer, Aggravated Assault on a police officer (4cts.), Resisting Arrest, Reckless Driving, Fraudulent Use of a License Plate, Illegal Possession of a Controlled Substance, and No Driver's License.

Darren Quinata, Chamorro, 19YOA, was arrested for the offense of resisting arrest.

Anthony Quenga, Chamorro, 19YOA, was arrested for the offense of resisting arrest.

Jerry B. Mantanona, Chamorro, 57YOA, was arrested for Illegal Possession of a Controlled Substance. He was Booked and Released.

Andrew Toves, Darren Quinata, and Anthony Quegna were Booked and Confined at the Department of Corrections.

The case is Closed and forwarded to the Attorney General's Office for their information and prosecution.
