Cita was called to her eternal rest on May 5, 2025, at the age of 81. She devoted her life to her greatest passion—teaching piano—to countless students, from young children in elementary school to adult learners. Though she stood at just 4 feet 7 inches from a scoliosis condition diagnosed in her early years, her unwavering will and determination far exceeded her physical stature. Cita was one of the island's pioneering classical piano teachers, known and respected throughout the community. With a Bachelor's Degree in Music Pedagogy from Santa Isabel College in Manila, she built a lifelong career in the comfort of her home. Her studio became a haven where students came not only to learn how to play the piano but also to discover the joy and beauty of music. Since the 1970s, Cita consistently taught between 25 and over 70 students at any given time, ranging from beginners to advanced performers. Her annual piano recitals became a cherished island tradition, drawing large audiences to the grand ballrooms of the island's finest hotels. Even well past retirement age and while managing physical limitations, Cita remained devoted to her students and her craft. Her resilience, love for teaching, and the strength of the relationships she cultivated allowed her to continue doing what she loved until the very end. Cita's legacy lives on through the many lives she has helped and touched. Her generosity, passion, and inspiring spirit will be remembered always.

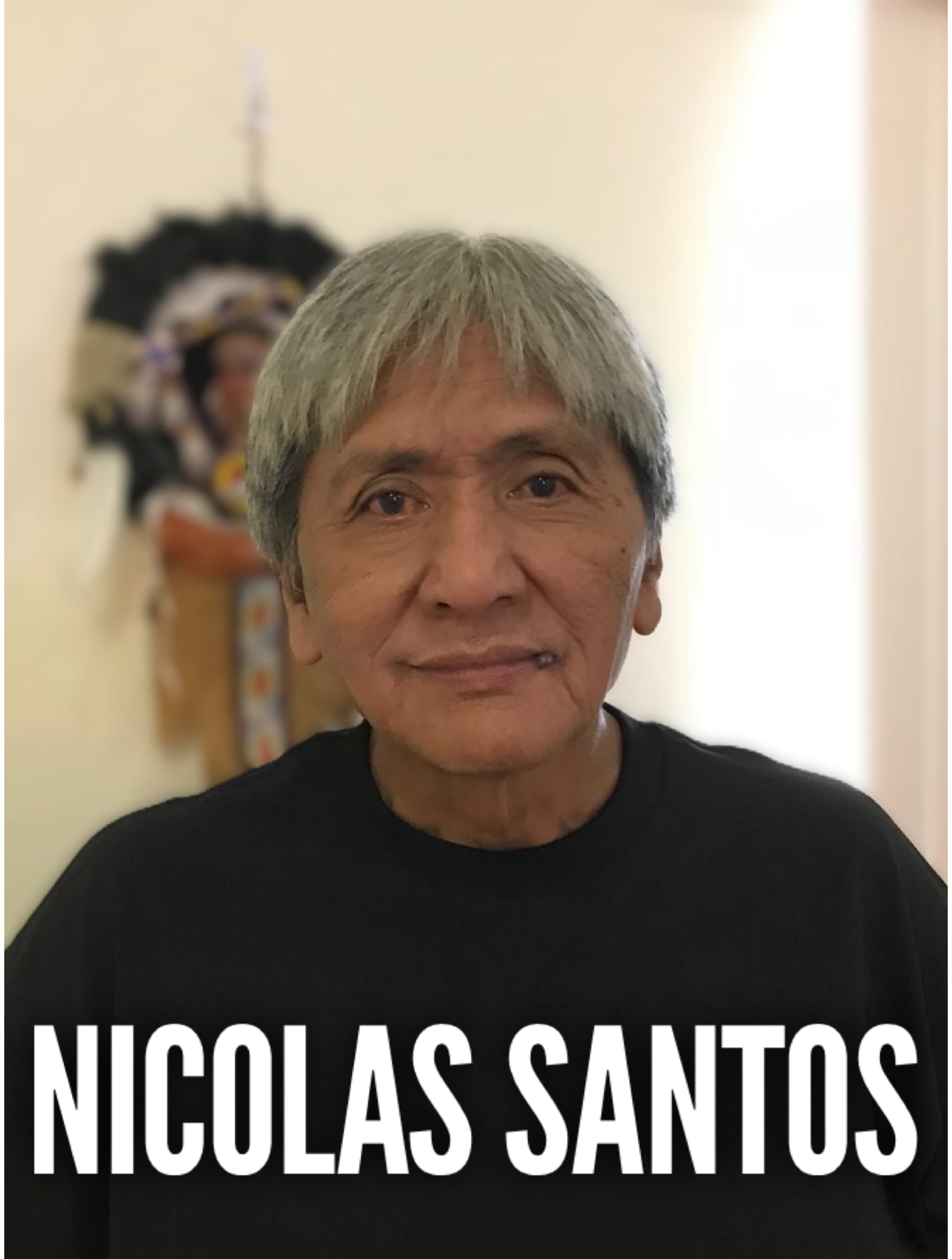
